She made her debut with the Leningrad philharmonic at 16. As a soloist of "State Concert" and "Soviet Union Concert", she gave concerts in Russia, Estonia, Ukraine, Germany, France, Bulgaria... She was professor at the Conservatory of Leningrad. After teaching in that school for 10 years, she accepted a position of piano Professor in the Russian Academy of Music in Moscow (Gnessin Institute). Natalya Antonova has given hundreds of master classes throughout the world and is now professor at the Eastman School in Rochester, U.S.A.

Fee advance

The application form must be accompanied by the fee advance of **200 €**, plus **50 €** of registration fee (not included in the student fee). The fee advance is refundable, in the event of cancellation by the participant if notice is given until one month before beginning of the chosen course. In the case of the application being denied by the professor the whole deposit (fee advance and registration fee) will be refunded. The Balance of **650 €** is paid the day of arrival in Moulin.
